Ald. Treis as chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

**Application for a Class B Beer & Liquor license by Maggiano's/Corner Bakery Holding Corp., d/b/a/ Maggiano's Little Italy, 2500 North Mayfair Road, Angela DuChac, agent**

The police had no objections to granting the license.

Ms DuChac told the committee that Maggiano's is excited and happy to be coming to Mayfair Mall and Wauwatosa.

Brendan McClusky, Maggiano's general manager, told the committee they plan to open on June 26, 2003. He also said the restaurant will have banquet facilities, the entrance will be from the parking lot, and there will be patio seating accommodating approximately twelve tables.

In response to Ald. Grimm's questions, Mr. McClusky said the hours of operation will be from 11:15 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on weekdays and until 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. The bar area will not be open later than the restaurant.

**Request by Timothy Capper of Colonel Hart's, 7342 West State Street, for a liquor license extension**

Mr. Capper told the committee he is requesting the license extension on May 31, 2003, from 1:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. for a Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation fund raiser. He would like to include live music which would end at approximately 5:00 p.m. Mr. Capper also said he has held fund raisers for the last five years and has had no complaints from the neighbors.

Chief Weber told the committee that the police have not had complaints in the past and have no objections.

Ald. Grimm said that Colonel Hart's is in his district and that he hadn't received any complaints either.
