ALSO PRESENT: Chief Weber, Police; Ms Thorson Aldana, Asst. City Atty.

Ald. Treis as chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Application for an operator license by Catherine Evanich, 2345 Brooksprings Drive #2, Brookfield

Ms Evanich explained the circumstances of her violations. She also told the committee that she is working as a bartender to support her two children. She was sorry things turned out the way they did and doesn't expect to have any more trouble.

Chief Weber reviewed Ms Evanich's violations and mentioned that she had also paid her fines.

Ald. Bruderle-Baran explained that the committee wants to establish what efforts Ms Evanich has made and that she has completed the court requirements. In response to Ald. Bruderle-Baran's questions, Ms Evanich told the committee that she has a current driver's license, has completed her classes, has held her current position for four years and works during the day.

Moved by Ald. Sullivan, seconded by Ald. Grimm to recommend that since Ms Evanich has completed her classes, paid her fines, worked at the same location for four years, is a mature individual raising two children and has had nothing on her record since March 22, 2001, her application be approved with a six month review – 6

Application for an operator license renewal by Richard Sasser, 6738 W. Lisbon Avenue #1, Milwaukee

Chief Weber reviewed Mr. Sasser's record and told the committee that he has a case pending. The jury trial is set for September 22, 2003.

Mr. Sasser explained the circumstances of his current incident.

Atty. Thorson Aldana explained some of the options available to the committee. There was general discussion as to how to handle the matter.

In response to Ald. Sullivan's questions, Mr. Sasser told the committee that he has held his position for approximately eight years. Mr. Sasser is also aware that he can continue to work without an operator license as long as he is under the direct supervision of a licensed operator.

Moved by Ald. Sullivan, seconded by Ald. Ecks to hold the matter pending the outcome of Mr. Sasser's court appearance on September 22, 2003 – 6

Application for an operator license by Nicholas Schneider, 215 W. Maple Street #508, Milwaukee

Chief Weber reviewed Mr. Schneider's violation. Mr. Schneider has paid his fine and has no other violations on his record.

Mr. Schneider briefly explained the circumstances and said that he had not made a smart decision.

Application for an operator license renewal by Travis McCall, 3361 N. 38th Street, Milwaukee

Mr. McCall was not present.

The chair directed the City Clerk to request Mr. McCall appear at the meeting of September 2, 2003.

Moved by Ald. Ecks, seconded by Ald. Sullivan to request the police provide additional information regarding Mr. Weil at a special meeting to be held on August 5, 2003 – 6
