Ald. Treis in the Chair called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

Operator License – Rebecca L. Wieloch

The committee reviewed an application by Rebecca L. Wieloch, 827 N. 17th Street, for an Operator license for the period ending June 30, 2004.

Chief Weber reported on two alcohol-related convictions, which Ms. Wieloch had acknowledged on her application. She completed a six-month driver safety course and said she regrets her past actions. In response to questions, she spoke of having matured and having a new sense of responsibility. She was recently promoted from another Noodles & Company location to the position of assistant manager in Wauwatosa. She indicated that she previously held licenses in Pewaukee and Oconomowoc.

Committee members expressed some concern about the violations but discussed mitigating factors including the applicant's age, completion of counseling, type of employment, and the fact that the violations were acknowledged on the application. A six-month review was deemed advisable. Ms. Wieloch was cautioned about having any further violations.

recommend to Council approval of the license contingent upon
