Proposed Ordinance - Parking Restrictions on Harley Davidson Avenue

The proposed ordinance amends Section 11.32.080 of the Code by prohibiting parking in designated locations on Harley Davidson Avenue. Mr. Kappel reported that Harley Davidson requested the change and paid for installation of signs. This restricts parking on the roadway parallel to Capitol Drive.

Temporary Traffic Control Measures on Harley Davidson Avenue during 100th Anniversary Events

Mr. Kappel reported on a request by Harley Davidson for temporary traffic control measures on Harley Davidson Avenue in connection with their upcoming 100th anniversary events, August 27-30, 2003, during which they expect several thousand visitors to their Capitol Drive plant. They have requested a one-way northbound on Harley Davidson Drive from the Capitol Drive entrance to the second driveway to the north (which is the main trucking entrance) as well as temporary no parking in that same area. They will handle most of the traffic control themselves with the exception of one-way and temporary no parking signage.

Mr. Kappel indicated that both Chief Weber and Lt. Weiss of the Police Department have been consulted and endorse the temporary changes. Section 11.12.020 of the Code authorizes the chief of police, mayor, and/or the city administrator to institute temporary regulations for up to 30 days for emergencies or temporary events. Notification of this committee is required.
