Ald. Krol in the Chair called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Proposed Ordinance – One-Hour Parking on N. 77th Street and Mary Ellen Place

Reviewing previous discussions, Mr. Kappel reported that the proposed ordinance will remove one-hour restrictions on N. 77th Street adjacent to the building at 7700 W. Blue Mound Road to allow 5-6 spaces of employee parking. It will impose one-hour restrictions Monday through Friday on the neighborhood streets to the north.

Completion of 90-Day Trial of Two-Hour Parking on W. North Avenue between N. 63rd and N. 64th Streets

Mr. Kappel reported that there have been no complaints about the trial change from one hour to two-hour restrictions on the north side of W. North Avenue between N. 63rd and N. 64th Streets. This makes the restrictions on the north side of the street uniform between N. 61st and N. 67th Streets.

Council introduction of an ordinance to establish the two-hour

Notification of Temporary Waiver of No Parking Restrictions

Mr. Kappel reported that Tushaus Computer Services, 10400 Innovation Drive, has requested permission to use on-street parking on Innovation and Research Drives, if needed, for any parking lot overflow in connection with a 10th anniversary event in their parking lot on September 24, 2003, from 3 to 7 p.m. The Board of Public Works approved the parking lot event and recommended temporarily lifting the parking restrictions by means of the provisions under Sec. 11.12.020 of the Code, which allows the police chief, mayor, and city administrator to make temporary regulations to cover special conditions and also requires notification of this committee. Mr. Kappel, therefore, informed the committee that police will be requested to not enforce the existing no parking regulations during the specified time period.

The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
