TRAFFIC AND SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
Tuesday, September 9, 2003

Ald. Krol in the Chair called the meeting to order at 7:42 p.m. -4

Request for Removal of Parking Restriction on east side of N. 70th Street

Mr. Kappel reported that the manager of Outpost Foods, 7000 W. State Street, has requested the removal of the two-hour parking restriction on the east side of N. 70th Street from north of the first drive at the Pick & Save parking lot to the end of the block. Restrictions placed near the driveways within the past three months to facilitate access would remain in place. Mr. Kappel recommended a 90-day trial of the requested change. Outpost Foods would be responsible for the estimated \$18 cost of removing signage.

Ald. Grimm, 4th District, was present and indicated that all affected parties seem to be satisfied with the suggested change.

Moved by Ald. Matthews, seconded by Ald. Herzog to approve a 90-day trial as recommended. Ayes: 4

Request for Parking Restriction Changes on W. Wisconsin Avenue between N. 67th and N. 68th Streets

Mr. Kappel reported that a local resident, Thomas Pfeil, has requested removal of the two-hour parking restriction on W. Wisconsin Avenue between N. 67th and N. 68th Streets between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. The restriction was put in place in connection with a medical clinic at 68th and Wells. The clinic recently moved from the area, so neighboring residents would like to have the parking restored. Mr. Kappel recommended a 90-day trial. There are additional rush-hour restrictions in this area that would remain.

Ald. Grimm, 4th District, reported that he spoke with Mr. Pfeil today, who confirmed his support for the change.

Moved by Ald. Treis, seconded by Ald. McCarthy to approve a 90-day trial as recommended –

Asked about the vacant clinic site, Mr. Kappel indicated that he knows of no plans for the building that would generate any problems with on-street parking.

Vote on the motion, Ayes: 4

Proposed Ordinance – Two-Hour Parking on portions of W. North Avenue

The committee reviewed the proposed ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 to create a two-hour parking zone on portions of W. North Avenue. Mr. Kappel reported that the restrictions cover the north side of the street between N. 63rd and N. 64th Streets. This will make restrictions uniform on the north side of W. North Avenue from N. 61st to N. 67th Street.
