Ald. Treis as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

**Class A beer and liquor license application by Badesha Corporation, d/b/a Tosa Liquor, 6607 W. North Avenue, Manjinder Singh, agent**

Capt. Reit stated that there were no police concerns. Mr. Singh was present, but did not wish to comment.

**Class B beer and liquor license application by Mayfair Liquor Mart, 3122 N. Mayfair Road, Hristo A. Hristev, sole proprietor and agent**

Capt. Reit stated that a check of the applicants bar record revealed one violation for selling alcohol to an underage individual. Mr. Hristev stated that the case was determined to be a mistake because the person presented a false identification card. He added that this was his only violation in seven years, and he has confiscated a number of false identification cards since then.

Ald. Treis, in reference to a letter of opposition from Ald. Maher, informed the Committee that an owner of a gas station was opposed to the applicant's store because competition would result. He went on to say that at the Plan Commission meeting of December 12, 2005 the applicant stated that the owner of the gas station contacted him and said that he has no problem with Mayfair Liquor Mart because competition will be minimal. Ald. Subotich asked if there is an issue with parking at the store location. Mr. Kesner replied that there is not.

Ald. Grimm and Ald. Treis expressed concern about the sale to underage person violation.

**Operator license application by Katy L. Dougall, 4345 N. 87<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, for the period ending June 30, 2006**

Capt. Reit stated that the applicant had two violations on her record and no pending cases. Ms. Dougall said that she made mistakes and has learned from them. She added that she is able to support her son with the money she makes and the flexible hours at the Cheesecake Factory. Capt. Reit stated that a forgery charge the applicant indicated on the application did not appear. Ms. Dougall stated that it was a problem with an old roommate that has been resolved. Ald. Subotich thanked the applicant for her honesty on the application.

**Operator license application by Sacha L. Korpela, 2800 S. 44<sup>th</sup> Street, West Allis, for the period ending June 30, 2006**

Capt. Reit stated that the applicant had a warrant that was withdrawn and provided a list of traffic violations to Ald. Krill for review. Ms. Korpela stated that she has a substantial amount of tickets that began with unpaid parking citations. She went on to say that she has been paying on the tickets and is trying to get them under control. Mr. Kesner said she is on the right track to getting the citations taken care of. Ald. Birschel pointed out that the applicant does not have any alcohol related violations. Ald. Krill added that the applicant disclosed all violations.
