### **TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING Tuesday, February 13, 2007**

PRESENT: Alds. Donegan (7:45 p.m.), Grimm, Herzog, Minear, Treis (7:44 p.m.) -5

ALSO PRESENT: W. Kappel, Dir. of Public Works; Chief Barry Weber, Police Dept.

Ald. Grimm as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:42 p.m. -3

#### **Ordinance – No Left Turns on Watertown Plank Road at N. 86th Street**

The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance amending Section 11.36.190 of the Code to prohibit left turns for westbound traffic on Watertown Plank Road at N. 86th Street. Mr. Kappel noted that a new left-turn arrow will be installed to facilitate left turns at N. 87th Street.

Moved by Ald. Herzog, seconded by Ald. Minear to recommend to Council adoption of the ordinance. Ayes: 3

#### **Ordinance – Two-Hour Parking on W. Meinecke Avenue between N. 86th and N. 88th Streets**

The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 of the Code to add two-hour parking restrictions on W. Meinecke Avenue between N. 86th and N. 88th Streets.

Mr. Kappel expressed some concern with setting a precedent about instituting restrictions when successful businesses impact parking. Ald. Herzog noted past situations such as Briggs & Stratton parking overflow, however, and favored handling each situation on a case-by-case basis.

Moved by Ald. Herzog, seconded by Ald. Minear to recommend to Council adoption of the ordinance. Ayes: 5

#### **Ordinance – Parking Restrictions in Roosevelt School Area**

The committee reviewed a proposed ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 of the Code by adding the following parking restrictions on the east side of N. 73rd Street between W. Wright and W. Clarke Streets: 1) no standing, stopping or parking on school days from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 4 p.m., and 2) three-hour parking between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. These changes have helped prevent cars from congregating on that side of Roosevelt School and

helped develop a clockwise traffic pattern around the school, according to the principal and as observed by Mr. Kappel.

Asked about enforcement, Chief Weber said that police try to give extra attention to school areas. He will check further on this particular area.

Moved by Ald. Donegan, seconded by Ald. Treis to recommend to Council adoption of the ordinance. Ayes: 5
