**Request for Repairs to Potter Road Railroad Crossing**

Mr. Kappel reported that the Union Pacific Railroad has not responded to a request for repair of the at-grade railroad crossing on Potter Road west of Mayfair Road. As outlined previously, the next step in the recommended process would be to ask the Wisconsin State Railroad Commissioner to investigate the condition of the crossing.

**Completion of 90-Day Trial of No Parking on N. 70th Street**

Mr. Kappel reported that there were no complaints during the 90-day trial of no parking at any time on the east side of N. 70th Street from 1442 N. 70th Street to Blanchard Street. The trial was a compromise measure that was arrived at after a series of meetings with residents and members of the Old Catholic Church, which is located mid-block. The Chair reported that he spoke to one resident yesterday who indicated that the restrictions are working out fairly well.

**Completion of 90-Day Trial of No Parking on Martha Washington Drive**
