**TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
Tuesday, December 11, 2007**

Ald. Grimm as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

Exceptions to Trial Parking Restrictions on N. 109th Street South of W. Blue Mound Road

Mr. Kappel reported that a 90-day trial of no parking from 5:30 p.m. to 2 a.m. is underway on the east side of N. 109th Street between W. Blue Mound Road and W. Michigan Street. This measure is part of the effort to address the impact of Mo's Irish Pub patrons on the neighborhood. At a neighborhood meeting last week, area residents requested an exception to the restrictions to allow residents to park in front of their homes on Sundays and holidays when there is less Mo's traffic. Since the 90-day trial is nearing its conclusion, Mr. Kappel suggested introduction of an ordinance to implement both the 90-day trial restrictions and the exceptions at this time. In the time between introduction and adoption of the ordinance, any issues that might still arise could be addressed.

Ald. Hanson said that the new restrictions seem to be relieving some of the parking problems in this neighborhood. He concurred with making the changes permanent.

Jim Dettman, 518 N. 109th Street, also reported that the trial restrictions have relieved the pressure on 109th Street.

Moved by Ald. Treis, seconded by Ald. Minear to recommend to Council introduction of an ordinance implementing the trial restrictions as well as the newly recommended exceptions. Ayes: 4
