ALSO PRESENT: A. Kesner, Interim City Admin./City Attorney; Police Chief B. Weber;

Ald. Krol as chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Operator license application for Kelly A. Theoharis, 2435 N. Calhoun Road, Brookfield, for the period ending June 30, 2007

The chair noted the applicant was present. Chief Weber asked Ms. Theoharis if she had her court date for recent alcohol related offenses. Ms. Theoharis said it was postponed until September 5, 2006. Ald. Becker suggested that Ms. Theoharis' record be reviewed in six months. Ald. Hanson asked what would happen if she is convicted in September; Ms. Theoharis said it appears that she will be charged with a lesser charge. Chief Weber said that she could continue to work as long as she doesn't have any new charges.

Moved by Ald. Becker, seconded by Ald. Birschel to recommend approval with a review in 6 months -5

Operator license application for Shontae D. Love, 5309 N. 29th Street, Milwaukee, for the period ending June 30, 2007

The chair noted the applicant was not present and that this was her second opportunity to appear.

Moved by Ald. Hanson, seconded by Ald. Ewerdt to recommend denial of application -5

Operator license application for Margaret E. Burns, 102 E. White Oak Way, Mequon, for the period ending June 30, 2007

The chair noted the applicant was present. Ms. Burns did not disclose her record on the application and Chief Weber explained that the convictions in 1999 and 2004 meant that she was uncooperative. Ald. Becker said that because she did not disclose this information on her application it raises suspicion. Chief Weber suggested issuing the license and reviewing Ms. Burns' record in six months.

Class B Beer and Reserve Class B Liquor license and Economic Development Grant application by Il Mito, Inc. d/b/a Il Mito Enoteca, 6913 W. North Avenue, Michael M. Feker, Agent

Michael Feker was present and stated that he has changed the type of restaurant from a bistro to a fine dining restaurant requiring a full liquor license. Atty. Kesner explained to the committee that this was a Reserve liquor license and included an Economic Development Grant application.
