Ald. Becker as chair called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM.

Operator License application by Andrew R. Fawley, 3133 S. 84th Street, Milwaukee

Mr. Fawley was present. Ald. Birschel asked about the lack of information on his application and Mr. Fawley stated that he didn't understand the question and didn't want to bother the clerk's office staff, but he did disclose information on the police application. Ald. Didier questioned his judgment. Ald. Ewerdt has reservations about issuing Mr. Fawley an operator's license. Ald. Birschel explained to Mr. Fawley the importance of honesty and consistency on the applications. Mr. Fawley submitted a letter from his employer which is placed in his file.
