Meeting - Tuesday, March 11, 2008

Ald. Krol as chair called the meeting to order at 7:32 PM.

Request by The Club Tap, 8828 W. North Avenue, for a temporary extension of the licensed premises to include the parking lot on Sunday, April 6, 2008 from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM for its annual Chile Contest.

Mr. William Poull was present. This request was submitted for the second time due to inclement weather, which cancelled the first approved request, scheduled for February 17, 2008. The committee had no concerns about the event.

Motion by Ald. Birschel, seconded by Ald. Didier to recommend approval of the licensed premises extension to include the parking lot. -6

Request by The Club Tap, 8828 W. North Avenue, for a temporary extension of the licensed premises to include the parking lot on Saturday, May 31, 2008 and Sunday, June 1, 2008 from 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM for its annual corn roast. This event is to include live music from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

Mr. William Poull was present. Mr. Poull will provide cell phone numbers for the alderpersons in his ward. The Club Tap assured the committee that the area would be cleaned up properly. Ald. Herzog was present during this time and spoke in favor of the annual corn roast.

Motion by Ald. Ewerdt, seconded by Ald. Didier to recommend approval of the licensed premises extension to include the parking lot. -6

Ms. Lowney was not present. It was the consensus of the committee to hold this item for the next scheduled meeting.
