### LEGISLATION, LICENSING & COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE

Ald. Birschel as chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

#### **Follow up presentation by representatives of UW-Milwaukee concerning possible development of a new engineering campus and innovation park in the northeast quadrant of the Milwaukee County Grounds**

Mayor Didier introduced the representatives from UW-Milwaukee; Chancellor Carlos Santiago, Vice Chancellor, Tom Luljak and UW-M Foundation President, David H. Gilbert. The presentation was to inform the new council of the vision and to update them on the progress concerning possible development of a new engineering campus and innovation park.

Chancellor Santiago stated that the Wauwatosa site for the Engineering campus is the first choice because of the clinical studies and research generated from the Medical College. Statistics show that research universities are the hub of economic quality. Therefore the Foundation continues to pursue the purchase of the property on the Northeast Quadrant of the Milwaukee County Grounds and the necessary steps to make this vision a reality.

Mayor Didier asked the Chancellor to reiterate his previous statements regarding the presence of taxable entities as part of this development. Chancellor Santiago said that there may be as much as 450,000 square feet of taxable uses within the development.

Ald. Herzog asked about policing and fire protection. The UW Campus presently has their own police department which partners with Milwaukee Police but they do not have their own fire department.

Ald. Nikcevich inquired about the time line in regard to salvaging the Eschweiler Buildings. UW is aware of the disintegrating process but is confident that they can be salvaged within the prospective timeline.

Ald. Donegan asked about approval dates. The UW representatives are scheduled to meet with the Milwaukee County Board in July and the Board of Regions in September.

Chancellor Santiago thanked the Mayor for having them present the update and said that they would be glad to come and present any and all progress.
