Memo from City Clerk regarding proposed amendment to Chapter 1.04 of the Code to allow for use of alternate sets of election workers

Ms. Ledesma explained that this ordinance would allow the city to have alternate sets of election workers to work split shifts as needed to staff the polling locations on November 4th and in the future for high-turnout elections. The use of split shifts on these days may ease the challenge of scheduling personnel.

Memo from Asst. City Attorney concerning proposed ordinance amendments to Chapter 6

Mr. Kesner explained that after reviewing the municipal code pertaining to Licenses and Fees it was determined that there are inconsistencies and provisions that are deemed out of date. The City Attorney's office in conjunction with the City Clerk's office has recommended changes to the code. The main objective of these changes is to eliminate specific references to fees in specific licenses and contain the fee schedule in one central location.
