### **TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING Tuesday, April 13, 2010**

#### **Completion of 90-Day Trial – Two-Hour Parking on N. 85<sup>th</sup> Street North of W. North Avenue**

Mr. Kappel reported that no comments were received during the 90-day trial of two-hour restrictions on the east side of N. 85<sup>th</sup> Street from W. North Avenue to the south lot line of 2320 N. 85<sup>th</sup> Street. The change from 30-minute restrictions makes this section consistent with the rest of the block and is in line with the needs of a new business at the northwest corner of 85<sup>th</sup> and North.

Moved by Ald. McBride, seconded by Ald. Wilke to recommend to Council introduction of an ordinance implementing the two-hour restrictions. Ayes: 5

#### **Completion of 90-Day Trial – Two-Hour Parking in Harwood Parking Mall, Pioneer Parking Lot**

Mr. Kappel identified the Harwood parking mall and Pioneer parking lot on an aerial map of Harwood Avenue between State Street and Wauwatosa Avenue. He reported that he worked with the Village Business Improvement District (BID) director to arrive at uniform restrictions for this area. The two-hour restrictions between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. except Sundays and holidays appear to be working out well; there have been no negative comments.
