Exception to Regular Construction Hours for Children's Hospital Project, 999 N. 92nd Street. In a letter dated April 14, 2004, Michael Radtke, Project Manager, Boldt Construction, N21 W23340 Ridgeview Parkway, Waukesha, requested a one-day exception to regular construction hours in order to begin work at 4 a.m. on Friday, April 16, 2004, at the Children's Hospital project, 999 N. 92nd Street. Section 15.02.150 of the City Code prohibits work between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.

Mr. Radtke said that 1,000 cubic yards of concrete will be poured on Friday involving about 100 truckloads. There would be too much congestion on the site from other construction vehicles, and traffic could back up onto Wisconsin Avenue or other public streets if the pour started during regular hours. With a 4 a.m. start, the work could be completed by 7 or 8 a.m. and any congestion or backup could be prevented. In response to questions, Mr. Radtke said that the truck route is from the east on Blue Mound Road to 95th Street. Construction vehicles avoid the freeway during rush hours.

It was moved by Ms. Mulroy, seconded by Ms. Welch to approve the requested exception to regular construction hours based on the exceptional circumstances outlined by the applicant. Ayes: 4
