**TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING
Tuesday, September 28, 2010
Committee Room #1**

PRESENT: Aids. McBride, Jay, Meaux, Pantuso, Wilke - 5

ALSO PRESENT: W. Kappel, Public Works Dir.

Ald. Meaux as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Review of 90-day trial changing two 30-minute parking spaces to 15 minutes on the west side of Underwood Avenue immediately north of Menomonee River Parkway

Mr. Kappel reported that they changed two spots at the end of Underwood Parkway to 15 minute spots basically to serve people running into the hardware store and for order pick up at Noodles. He noted that it is such a short amount of time that the businesses themselves will keep an eye on how they are being used.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. McBride to recommend introduction of the ordinance to Council – 5

Changing the one-hour to three-hour parking on the south side of North Avenue between N. 69th & N. 70th Streets

Mr. Kappel noted that restricting the parking to one hour is creating a hardship for the business owners. He recommended a 90-day trial changing the restriction to three hours on the south side of the street for now.

Michael Feker, 6913 W. North Avenue, commented that many of his customers are getting parking tickets and his lunch traffic has decreased. He would like to give more time for his lunch customers. Mr. Kappel added that Cranky Al's doesn't have a problem with this proposal.

Moved by Ald. McBride, seconded by Ald. Pantuso to approve a 90-day trial for the change from one-hour parking to three-hour parking on the south side of North Avenue between N. 69th and N. 70th Streets – 5

Ordinance amending Chapter 11.34.110 of the city code placing three 30-minute parking spaces and three 3-hour parking spaces west of the handicapped spaces in the Little Red Store municipal parking lot

Mr. Kappel explained that this was one of four amendments to the parking lot ordinance.

Moved by Ald. Jay, seconded by Ald. Wilke to recommend adoption of the ordinance to Council – 5

Ordinance amending Chapter 11.40.300 of the city code prohibiting trucking on N. 68th Street between W. Blue Mound Road and south city limits

Mr. Kappel reported that there have been no negative comments from residents or businesses regarding the prohibition.

Moved by Ald. McBride, seconded by Ald. Jay to recommend adoption of the ordinance to Council – 5

Ordinance amending Chapter 11.32.080 of the city code prohibiting parking on the north side of W. Keefe Avenue north of Menomonee River Parkway

Mr. Kappel explained that these parking restrictions are along the new playground. Residents can park on the park side and let their children out so they don't have to cross the street making it safer for the children. He recommended amending Chapter 11.32.080 of the city code to read as follows:

“Keefe Avenue – North side
(a) from Menomonee River Parkway to city limits”

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. McBride to recommend adoption of the ordinance to Council – 5
