TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING Tuesday, December 14, 2010 Committee Room #1

Ald. McBride as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

90-day trial for two-hour parking restrictions on the west side of the 2400 block of N. 86th Street

Mr. Wehrley commented that this is a conclusion of a 90-day trial for a two-hour parking restriction between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., except Sundays and legal holidays, on the west side in the 2400 block of N. 86th Street. He reported that he has not heard any feedback either negatively or positively from the neighbors.

Ald. Roznowski noted that there have always been parking issues at Sendik's especially with employee parking. He has received a number of emails concerning the parking restrictions. A few people were not happy and a number of others were fine with the situation the way it is. He added that there is nothing compelling to say that the two-hour parking restriction should not be continued.

Ald. Wilke asked if the emails contained any comments regarding the employee parking. Ald. Roznowski responded that the employees just move to other streets in the area. Ald. McBride mentioned that he has had discussions with Sendik's and they are eager to make the residents happy so they are willing to work with them on the issue.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. Jay to recommend an ordinance for introduction amending Section 11.32.080 of the city code to add a two-hour parking restriction on the west side of the 2400 block of N. 86th Street – 4

90-day trial on changing the one-hour parking restriction to three hours on the South Side of W. North Avenue between N. 69th and N. 70th Streets

Mr. Wehrley reported that this is the conclusion of another 90-day trial. He has received no positive or negative feedback.

Ald. McBride noted that the purpose of lengthening the parking restriction was to give more time for Il Mito's customers to have lunch or dinner. Ald. Nikceвич added that the only negative comment she heard was from Bartz Party Supply regarding customers having a harder time parking near the store.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. Wilke to recommend an ordinance for introduction amending Section 11.32.080 of the city code to increase the parking restriction on the south side of W. North Avenue between N. 69th and N. 70th Streets from one- hour to three-hour parking – 4

The meeting adjourned at 7:46 p.m.
