TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING Tuesday, January 4, 2011 Committee Room #1

Ald. Meaux as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:14 p.m.

Ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 of the city code to add two-hour parking restrictions on the west side of the 2400 block of N. 86th Street

Scott Bush, 2408 N. 86th Street, appreciated the efforts that were taking place; however, the ordinance amendment was not a fix. A lot of people are still parking in the wrong places. He said he was pro business and pro Sendiks, but the amendment might even make the situation worse. With the restriction in place people can only park on one side of the street when they can get a space.

Paul Baumler, 2420 N. 86th Street, felt the restriction was not a solution. People on the west side of the street have been getting tickets for parking in front of their own houses. Parking on the east side is infringing onto the owners' driveways. He felt in some ways the restriction has made things worse.

Ald. Roznowski noted that he has received limited input. At the last meeting he spoke with residents and most of them were against the restriction. Even the requestors have come to see that it isn't working and they are now neutral. Only one person is still in support of it.

Ald. Roznowski would like to have the item held in order to have further meetings with Sendiks and the neighbors. He reiterated that the majority do not want to see the restriction continued.

Ald. McBride observed that the best solution would be to sit down and discover what would be a better solution. He suggested denial of the amendment.

Moved by Ald. McBride, seconded by Ald. Pantuso to recommend denial of the ordinance amendment – 5

Ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 of the city code changing one-hour to three-hour parking on the south side of W. North Avenue between N. 69th and N. 70th Streets

Mr. Wehrley reported that he had received no negative or positive feedback. Ald. Nikceвич hadn't heard from any of the neighbors or businesses regarding the change from one-hour to three-hour parking on the south side of W. North Avenue between No. 69th and N. 70th Streets.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. McBride to recommend approval of the ordinance amending Section 11.32.080 changing one-hour to three-hour parking on the south side of W. North Avenue between N. 69th and N. 70th Streets – 5

The meeting adjourned at 7:31 p.m.
