Ald. Birschel as chair called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM

Held from previous meeting, Operator License application by Angela C. Verberne, 2479A N. 68th Street, Wauwatosa for the period ending June 30, 2009

The applicant was present. Chief Weber had no concerns. Ms. Aldana had no comments. Ms. Verberne explained her police report and the committee was satisfied.

Moved by Ald. Herzog, seconded by Ald. Nikcevich to recommend approval of Operator License application - 5

Held from previous meeting, Operator License application by Nicholas D. McDonald, W219 S7594 Crowbar Drive, Muskego for the period ending June 30, 2009

The applicant was present. Chief Weber stated that Mr. McDonald disclosed more than the police report showed. Ald. Herzog asked the applicant about specific items on his police report. Ald. Herzog asked about the most recent offense. Mr. McDonald explained the circumstances behind the offense in question. Ald. Nikcevich asked the applicant about any lifestyle changes. Mr. McDonald said that he is in college, working full-time and feels that he has grown since those incidents. Ald. Birschel talked to the applicant about being able to control his temper in the workplace.
