Ald. Birschel as chair called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM

Held from previous meeting, Operator License application by Aprille A. Spoor, 4889 Terry Avenue, Brown Deer for the period ending June 30, 2009

Re-referred by Council, request for reconsideration of Operator License application by Gerald M. Pfeifer, 2000 W. National Avenue, Milwaukee, for the period ending June 30, 2009

Mr. Pfeifer was present. Ald. Birschel talked to Mr. Piccurro, Mr. Pfeifer's employer, and he verified that Mr. Pfeifer had never served to any one underage and that he has never had any problems serving the public during his employment in previous family businesses. Mr. Piccurro recommended that the committee decide on this matter as they see fit. Ald. Hanson said that Mr. Piccurro spoke very highly of Mr. Pfeifer to him as well.

Moved by Ald. Hanson, seconded by Ald. Dennik to recommend approval of operator license with a review at the time of renewal

Ald. Nikceвич stated to Mr. Pfeifer that he needs to take this responsibility seriously and he responded that he will do his job responsibly and respectfully.

Ald. Herzog reviewed Mr. Pfeifer's past and brought to the committee's attention that Mr. Pfeifer still had an outstanding citation from 2006. Ald. Herzog then addressed the committee and stated that if they recommend approval of this license application than they would have to lower the bar and recommend approval of all applications whether they disclose all information or not, and he reminded them that they have denied others with lesser items of concern.

Capt. Weiss verified the outstanding fine that showed up on the police report. Mr. Pfeifer said that he paid that fine from 2006 but that he would look into it and take care of it.

Ald. Dennik said that Mr. Pfeifer needs to pay that fine before the common council meeting next week, providing proof of payment to the Clerk's office.
