Update on the ATC electric transmission line application process

The city has intervened with other groups and the city is being represented by Stafford Rosenbaum. He outlined important dates during the process and noted that the PSC is asking for a 270 day hearing schedule. He showed maps of ATC's proposed power lines installation.
