TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

Tuesday, June 12, 2012

Ald. Wilke as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

90-day report on no parking restrictions on Elm Lawn and on Watertown Plank Road

The committee reviewed a 90-day trial regarding a here to corner no parking restriction on Elm Lawn as it intersects with Watertown Plank Road as well as rush hour parking restrictions installed on Watertown Plank Road from Elm Lawn to Robertson Street. Mr. Porter noted that public input was not a problem in this instance. The affected properties, Eddie Martini's restaurant and the Medical College could not come to a consensus on the college renting out parking spaces, but it seems that the restaurant is still trying to work out a solution. The 90-day trial went well so he was asking that the committee approve the restrictions as permanent.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. McBride to recommend introduction of an ordinance amendment for parking restrictions on Elm Lawn and on Watertown Plank Road – 5

90-day trial of request for a No Parking Any Time zone on the south side of Wisconsin Avenue between N. 108th and N. 109th Streets

The committee reviewed a 90-day trial of a No Parking Any Time zone on the south side of Wisconsin Avenue between N. 108th and N. 109th Streets. Mr. Porter commented that he was approached by a resident who felt that there was a sight obstruction caused by cars parking in that area. Mr. Porter felt the concern was justified.

Moved by Ald. Roznowski, seconded by Ald. Pantuso to approve a 90-day trial of a no parking any time zone on the south side of Wisconsin Avenue between N. 108th and N. 109th Streets – 5

90-day report on 15-minute parking zone on the north side of Warren Avenue between Wauwatosa and Underwood Avenues near Lincoln School

The committee reviewed a 90-day report regarding a 15-minute parking zone on the north side of Warren Avenue between Wauwatosa and Underwood Avenues near Lincoln School. Mr. Porter commented that this was requested by the aldermen of the district and the Lincoln School principal so that parents will be able to run in and out if they have to drop anything off for their children. He added that it seems to be working.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. Moldenhauer to recommend introduction of an ordinance amendment for a 15-minute parking zone on the north side of Warren Avenue between Wauwatosa and Underwood Avenues near Lincoln School – 5

90-day report regarding 2 hour parking restriction at 11127 Blue Mound Road

The committee reviewed a 90-day report regarding a two hour parking restriction at 11127 W. Blue Mound Road. Mr. Porter noted that this would be located in front of the store at that address. The parking restriction at that location would be from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Moved by Ald. Roznowski, seconded by Ald. Moldenhauer to recommend introduction of an ordinance amendment for a two hour parking restriction at 11127 W. Blue Mound Road between the hours of 9:00 a.m and 6:00 p.m. daily – 5
