TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING

Ald. Wilke as Chair called the meeting to order at 8:14 p.m.

Resolution amending the stop sign map by adding the installation of a four-way stop sign at N. 73rd Street and Hillcrest Drive

Ordinance amending Chapter 11.32.080 of the city code by adding an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) – compliant parking space at 6502 W. North Avenue

Ordinance amending Chapter 11.32.080 of the city code by installing a no parking zone on the south side of W. Center Street from 67th to 68th Streets from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Concordia University School – Pilgrim Campus, 6717 W. Center Street

This proposed resolution and these proposed ordinance amendments had been reviewed by the committee at an earlier meeting as 90-day trials, the committee decided to vote on three of them together.

Moved by Ald. Pantuso, seconded by Ald. Roznowski to recommend approval to amend the stop sign map by adding the installation of a four-way stop sign at N. 73rd Street and Hillcrest Drive and to request that two ordinances for introduction be drafted to amend Chapter 11.32.080 of the city code by adding an ADA compliant parking space at 6502 W. North Avenue and by installing a no parking zone on the south side of W. Center Street from 67th to 68th Streets from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Concordia University School – Pilgrim Campus, 6717 W. Center Street – 5

Resolution amending the stop sign map by adding a four-way stop sign at N. 91st Street and W. Meinecke

This proposed resolution had been reviewed by the committee at an earlier meeting as a 90-day trial.

Sarah LeRand, 2125 N. 90th Street, commented that her neighborhood had signed a large petition and submitted the signatures to the committee. They feel very strongly that the four-way stop signs will be an added measure of safety for their neighborhood.

Moved by Ald. McBride, seconded by Ald. Roznowski to recommend amending the stop sign map to add a four-way stop sign at N. 91st Street and W. Meinecke – 5
