Re-application for an Operator License by Andrea K. Luke, 514 S. 75th Street, Milwaukee, for the period ending June 30, 2013

Ms. Luke was present. The applicant applied six months ago for an Operator License and was denied by the LLC Committee.

Ald. Ewerdt gave Ms. Luke the opportunity to explain that she did not disclose everything on her previous application.

Chief Weber had no other concerns regarding Ms. Luke's police record.

Memo from the Asst. City Attorney recommending amendments to Sections 6.60.010 and 6.60.030 of the Wauwatosa Municipal Code concerning soda water licensing to reflect current statutory reference.

Eileen Miller Carter gave a brief explanation of the recommended amendment to provide consistent terminology, to foster clarity and require all soda water vendors, regardless of packaging, to obtain a city issued license. The city attorney recommends deleting the term "bottled" from the provision to achieve this objective.
