Ald. Donegan as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:33p.m.

Operator License application by Anthony J. Keller, W342 N4906 W. Lindy Lane, Nashotah, WI for the period ending June 30, 2013.

Mr. Keller was present. The applicant explained that he had been reviewed by the committee one year ago with a six month review. He did not follow through with that license and therefore applied again for an operator license. The police report did not change in the past year.

Ald. Dubinski asked Mr. Keller if he went through any counseling. Mr. Keller stated that he has gone to all of the counseling required and has put his life in order. He also stated that he learned so much from the counseling sessions and that he is in compliance and he is not on probation.

Mr. Poull was not present. Mr. Kesner spoke on Mr. Poull’s behalf. He explained to the committee that The Club Tap has a good rapport with the city and the neighborhood. This is a yearly event for The Club Tap and Mr. Poull provides contact numbers for the aldermen in his district, the Police Department and notifies the neighbors of the event.

Ald. Birschel and Ald. Dubinski both made note that there has never been any problems or complaints regarding this annual event.
