1. Class "B" Beer License application by Wisconsin Wings, Inc., d/b/a Wingstop, 12132 W. Capitol Drive, Kurt J. Hodermann, agent, for the period ending June 30, 2014

Mr. Hodermann was present and gave a brief summary of his business history in Wauwatosa. He currently owns a Subway restaurant on 68th and North Avenue and on 76th and Blue Mound Road.

He plans to renovate two sites into one at Stratford Plaza located at 12132 W. Capitol Drive. Wingstop is a chain restaurant out of Dallas Texas that specializes in chicken wings. There are locations in West Milwaukee, Glendale and Bayshore. The Wauwatosa site will seat 74 people and will only serve a variety of bottled beers. No liquor or draft beers.

The committee encouraged Mr. Hodermann in his newest business and thanked him for his continued interest in Wauwatosa.
