5. Report from the Director of Public Works regarding 90-day Trial of Stop Signs at the Intersection of 78th and Wright Streets

The committee reviewed a memo from the Public Works Director reviewing the completed 90-day trial of the stop sign at the intersection of 78th and Wright Streets.

Due to safety concerns this area was posted with a stop sign at this intersection in October 2013.

Mr. Porter said that staff has received no negative feedback and recommended that this be made permanent.

Ald. Pantuso said he has driven the area and felt it is useful to have the stop sign there. The neighbors in this area are very happy with the sign and have not had close calls when attempting to leave their driveways.

Ald. McBride noted that he was not in favor of this stop sign since it did not comply with the manual for stop signs. Since then he has driven it and although the area doesn't meet the criteria he felt the hill was daunting and the sign necessary.
