**Application for a Class B Beer & Class B Liquor License by Chamkaur, LLC d/b/a Indian Palace Restaurant, 11302 W. Blue Mound Road, Balhair S. Dulai, Agent**

Atty. Kesner and Capt. Bozicevich both told the committee that they had no objections to granting the license.

Balhair Dulai spoke on behalf of Chamkaur, LLC. Mr. Dulai told the committee that the bar area will be half the size of the current area. He would be delighted to be granted a license so he can go ahead with the restaurant renovations.
