Ald. Treis as Chair called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

Request by Wauwatosa West High School for a fireworks user permit at Hart Park on 10/4/02

Andy Zietlow, Student Council Advisor, represented Wauwatosa West. The fireworks display will be presented by Bartolotta Fireworks Co., Inc. It will be very similar to last year's display.

Moved by Ald. Sullivan, seconded by Ald. Grimm to recommend approval under the same conditions as last year – 6

Request by Curtis Michalak for discussion of potential application for a Class A Beer and Class A Liquor license (held from meeting of 7/30/02)

Capt. Bozicevich told the committee that the police again investigated Mr. Michalak's City of Milwaukee property violations. The properties are no longer owned by Mr. Michalak and there are no outstanding violations.

Atty. Kesner told the committee that he had looked into the possibility of granting Mr. Michalak a license on a probationary basis. He reported that this would not be a good option for the city. A probationary liquor license would hold the same bundle of rights as a regular liquor license.

Ald. Sullivan indicated that while he still has concerns about Mr. Michalak's record he is impressed by how Mr. Michalak has turned his life around.

Ald. Bruderle-Baran verified with Capt. Bozicevich that Mr. Michalak has sold all of his properties. The only violations on Mr. Michalak's record other than the property violations are from 1988. She asked Capt. Bozicevich for his recommendation.

Capt. Bozicevich told the committee that taking everything into consideration he would not oppose granting Mr. Michalak a license.

Mr. Michalak told the committee that he has no connection with the current owners. He intends to be an onsite manager and to make physical improvements to the site.

Ald. Treis indicated that the committee would be willing to consider a Class A Beer and Liquor license application made by Mr. Michalak.

Application for an operator license renewal by Patricia Dobosz, 7633 W. Palmetto Avenue, Milwaukee

Ms Dobosz did not appear at the meeting.

Atty. Kesner told the committee that Ms Dobosz's court date has been held until November, 8, 2002.

Moved by Ald. Bruderle-Baran, seconded by Ald. Ecks to hold the matter until Ms Dobosz's case has been disposed of – 6

License applications forwarded by the City Clerk for review

There were no applications forwarded for review.
