License applications forwarded by the City Clerk for review

The committee discussed the operator license renewal application made by Jeremy J. Koss. Mr. Koss has received one citation and been fined.

Progress report from Time Warner Cable on customer efforts

Hearing to consider non-renewal of food, soda water & alcohol licenses for Jitterz Coffee Tea House, 7606 W. State Street, Anthony Cutraro, Agent

Atty. Kesner addressed the committee. He explained that the reason for consideration of non-renewal is unpaid personal property tax as of June 4, 2002. Mr. Cutraro has agreed to an arraignment of half payment within 30 days and full payment within 60 days.

Atty. Kesner told the committee that under this payment arrangement he could recommend renewal.

Ald. Grimm verified with Atty. Kesner that if the payments aren't made the license could be non-renewed without further action.

Moved by Ald. Subotich, seconded by Ald. Grimm to renew the food, soda water and alcohol licenses of Jitterz Coffee Tea House contingent upon payment of personal property tax; ½ within 30 days and payment in full within 60 days – 5

Ms Dobosz' pre-trial conference was held June 14, 2002. The court ordered her case adjourned for a projected guilty plea. The plea date is scheduled for August 28, 2002.
