

Communicable Diseases and Immunizations

- ◆ Processed 706 calls regarding immunizations and 285 communicable diseases (CD) inquiries
- ◆ Investigated 405 vaccine-preventable and non-vaccine preventable CD investigations, including 140 sexually transmitted diseases (STDs)
- ◆ Investigated and contained 21 disease outbreaks or unusual events
- ◆ Administered 1105 non-flu vaccines to 648 clients at immunization clinics
- ◆ Administered 1208 seasonal flu vaccines at mass clinics throughout the city
- ◆ Investigated 12 food-borne illness complaints regarding restaurants; none of the events were found to have originated from Wauwatosa restaurants
- ◆ Conducted 555 inspections for licensed establishments including 111 retail food establishments, 47 city food, 46 vending machines, 288 restaurants, and 63 temporary restaurants
- ◆ Conducted 32 kitchen inspections for 18 public and private schools



Environmental Health and Emergency Preparedness

- ◆ Documented 140 nuisance complaints, resulting in 102 on-site inspections, 13 warning letters and/or clean up orders
- ◆ Inspected 11 human health hazard complaints with 4 verified hazards; verified complaints were issued orders for clean-up
- ◆ Met and collaborated with other city departments, businesses, and residents to ensure that complaints were handled in an efficient manner
- ◆ Identified and followed 10 lead-poisoned Wauwatosa children for having blood lead levels ≥ 10 $\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$
- ◆ Collaborated with the Wauwatosa Development Department staff and federal HUD representatives to pilot a weatherization grant protocol to prevent homes from developing a lead hazard which may poison young children
- ◆ Investigated 53 animal bite reports
- ◆ Issued 19 domestic animal quarantine orders
- ◆ Processed 18 specimens for rabies testing
- ◆ Inspected all 28 licensed pools



Healthy Growth and Development

- ◆ Provided services for over 154 participants from 104 Wauwatosa families with the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) nutrition supplement program
- ◆ Analyzed and reported on the 2010 telephone breastfeeding survey to assess the breastfeeding and infant feeding practices of Wauwatosa families
- ◆ Completed 54 tobacco compliance investigations in partnership with the Tosa Police Department and Tosa United
- ◆ Assessed 125 individuals on alcohol use and illegal/inappropriate drug use through the department's Adult Health Clinic program
- ◆ Assessed and evaluated 11 referrals for injury/violence nursing case management
- ◆ Assessed 573 birth records for high-risk maternal health issues
- ◆ Assessed and evaluated 1028 referrals for nursing case management services for varied healthy growth and development issues
- ◆ Conducted two *Love & Logic* six-week parenting classes in partnership with the Parenting Network and Lutheran Living Services
