

Ernest Flagg Stone Masonry House

7105 Grand Parkway

Following World War I, renowned New York architect Ernest Flagg developed a home construction system to address a national housing shortage by saving time, labor, and materials. Each Flagg house has ridge dormers, stone masonry construction, and a ground-hugging profile, but was an original design based on client needs. The home at 7105 Grand Parkway is one of five Flagg houses in Wauwatosa. All were constructed by Arnold F. Meyer.
