


First Congregational Church

1511 Church Street

First Congregational Church is Wauwatosa's oldest church. Founded in 1842, the congregation first met in schools and private homes. In 1853, it constructed a church on the present site. The current Georgian Revival church, designed by Edwin Kuenzli, was built in 1919 and expanded in 1959. It incorporates the 1853 sanctuary as a social hall. Its steeple is a replica of the tower on the Congregational Church in Williamstown, Massachusetts.
