

City of Wauwatosa Animal Regulations

Did you know????

- ◇ All dogs need to be leashed at all times. Dogs are not allowed to run at large on any public or private property (with the exception of designated county dog parks).



- ◇ The City of Wauwatosa municipal code states you may not possess more than a total of 3 cats or dogs or a combination of more than 3 animals in any residence, apartment, or property.

- ◇ All domestic dogs and cats are required to be vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian within 30 days of the animal reaching five months of age and then revaccinated within one year.



- ◇ A dog bite is a reportable offense. Any person with knowledge of a bite, attack or injury by a dog is required to report the incident to the City of Wauwatosa Police Department (stop by in person or call 414-.471-8430)

- ◇ All dogs must have visible licensing tags. Dogs without visible tags attached to a collar are presumed unlicensed and are subject to fines. The City of Wauwatosa Treasurer's Office assists with animal licensing.
