The City Of Wauwatosa hired 2 full time Youth Mental Health Social Workers to assist youth in Wauwatosa through partnerships with the Wauwatosa School District and private local schools. The Social Workers will be available to assist with mental health and resource needs. Referrals can be made by schools, families, and youth. The Social Worker is able to meet with individuals to assess needs, make referrals, and maintain follow up contact with youth, families, and schools when needed.
