

Thomas Benjamin Hart House

1609 Church Street

This fine Gothic Revival residence, with its unusual variety of decorative bargeboards, was built c. 1845. Charles Hart, the first permanent settler in Wauwatosa, had purchased the land in 1839. His brother, Thomas B. Hart, purchased the home in 1874. Thomas and members of his family lived here until 1910. Charles and Thomas Hart built a sawmill and gristmill in this community, which originally was known as Hart's Mills.
