

Lowell Damon House

2107 Wauwatosa Avenue

In 1844, pioneer Oliver Damon built the west part of this home, believed to be Wauwatosa's oldest surviving residential building. Oliver's son, Lowell, completed the Greek Revival front portion facing Wauwatosa Avenue in 1846. The Milwaukee County Historical Society owns the house and operates it as a museum.
