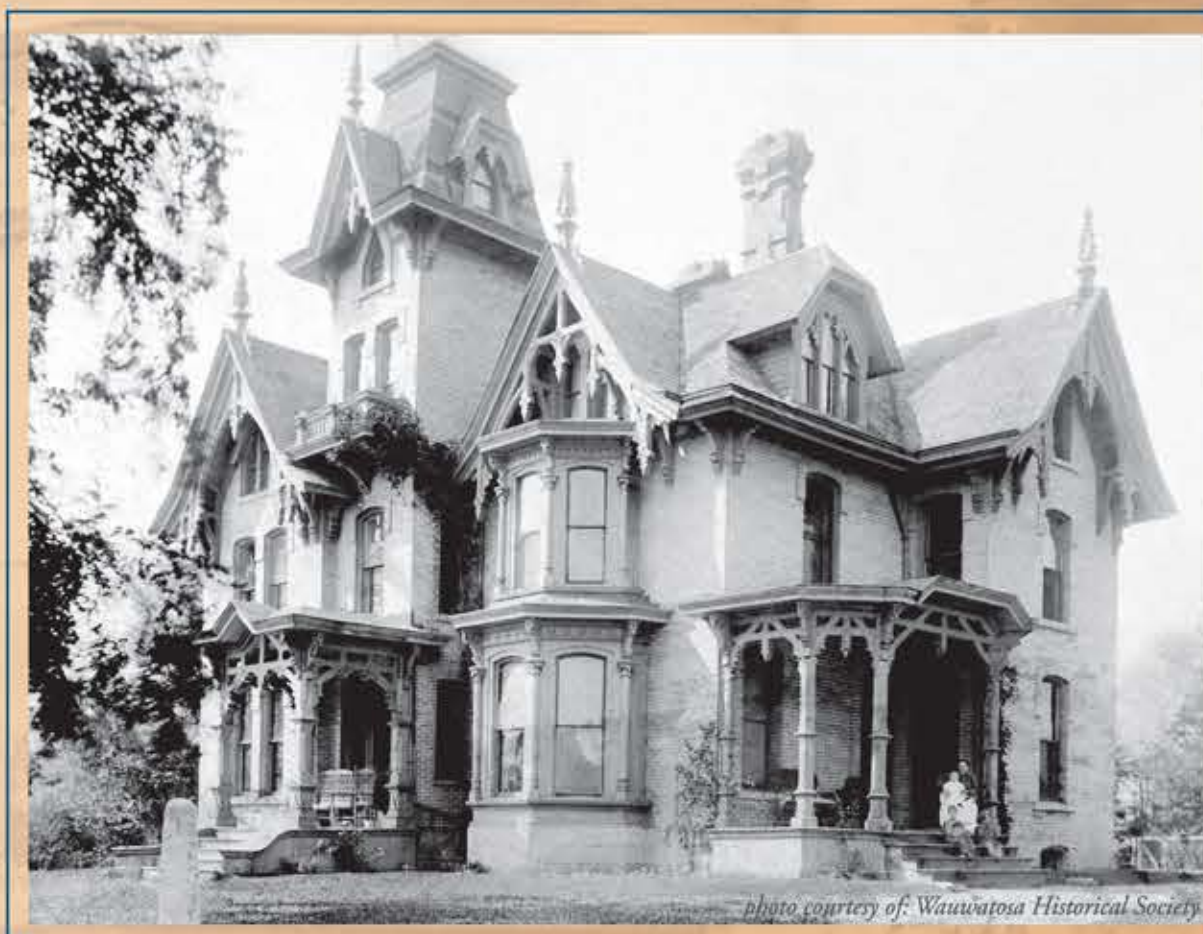


Fisk Holbrook Day Residence

8000 Milwaukee Avenue

Dr. Day built three architecturally unique homes in Wauwatosa. Only one of these, the Italianate "Sunnyhill" built in 1874, survives. Dr. Day served as a physician for the County Hospital. Family members would watch from the tower of his house for a signal indicating when Dr. Day was needed at the hospital. Dr. Day was also a nationally known geologist whose collections are now housed at Harvard University and the Greene Museum at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.
