Wauwatosa's Recreation Building opened in 1941 as the centerpiece of City Park, now known as Hart Park. The Colonial Revival-style building was designed by Wauwatosa architect Walter Domann and built by the federal Work Projects Administration. Renamed in 1974 to honor the park superintendent, Howard Muellner, the building was Milwaukee County's first indoor artificial ice rink and Wauwatosa's largest indoor recreational facility. Used for many activities, the Muellner Building is recognized for its contributions to Wauwatosa's social and recreational history.
