Rockway-Brookside Historic District

Residential Properties On Rockway Place And Brookside Place

This historic district comprises curvilinear, tree-lined streets with entrance pillars and brick sidewalks. It contains many examples of Tudor Revival-style residences constructed between 1924 and 1937. The homes have a high degree of integrity, characterized by multi-gabled sloping roofs, dominant chimneys, multiple-light windows, and half-timbering. Many of the homes were constructed by the Robert H. Smith Co., Inc. and original homeowners included members of various professional fields. The district is recognized for its architecture.
