

Wauwatosa June 1st 1897.

A meeting of the Common Council of the City of Wauwatosa was held at the City Hall on Tuesday June 1st 1897. at 7.30 o'clock P. M.

The Mayor in the Chair.
Roll called by the Clerk.

Present—Messrs. Bamback, Reed, Kallala, Zepher, Pister, Rogers, Wundersnow, Yehle and Mr. Mayor.

All of the above named members had previously subscribed the oath of office and were duly qualified to act—
By Mr. Bamback.

Resolved, that the Rules of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wauwatosa, be adopted as the Rules of the Common Council, until altered, amended or repealed by the vote of a majority of the members elect. The above was treated as a privileged Resolution, and was adopted by a unanimous vote of all the members present.

President of the Common Council, a City Clerk, a City Attorney, a Marshal or Chief of Police and a Street Commissioner.

Dated at Wauwatosa, Wisconsin, this first day of June 1897.
